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# **GLOSSARY OF ACRONYMS, TERMS, AND ABBREVIATIONS**

**ABC** – Approved Budget for the Contract.

**BAC** – Bids and Awards Committee.

**Bid** – A signed offer or proposal to undertake a contract submitted by a bidder in response to and in consonance with the requirements of the bidding documents. Also referred to as *Proposal* and *Tender*. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[c])

**Bidder** – Refers to a contractor, manufacturer, supplier, distributor and/or consultant who submits a bid in response to the requirements of the Bidding Documents. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[d])

**Bidding Documents** – The documents issued by the Procuring Entity as the bases for bids, furnishing all information necessary for a prospective bidder to prepare a bid for the Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and/or Consulting Services required by the Procuring Entity. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[e])

**BIR** – Bureau of Internal Revenue.

**BSP** – Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas.

**Consulting Services** – Refer to services for Infrastructure Projects and other types of projects or activities of the GOP requiring adequate external technical and professional expertise that are beyond the capability and/or capacity of the GOP to undertake such as, but not limited to: (i) advisory and review services; (ii) pre-investment or feasibility studies; (iii) design; (iv) construction supervision; (v) management and related services; and (vi) other technical services or special studies. (2016 revised IRR, Section 5[i])

**CDA -** Cooperative Development Authority.

**Contract** – Refers to the agreement entered into between the Procuring Entity and the Supplier or Manufacturer or Distributor or Service Provider for procurement of Goods and Services; Contractor for Procurement of Infrastructure Projects; or Consultant or Consulting Firm for Procurement of Consulting Services; as the case may be, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from PABAC1 Secretariat and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.

8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.

# SECTION II. INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

## 1. Scope of Bid

The Procuring Entity, **Philippine Army** wishes to receive Bids for the **Procurement of Grenade Launcher, 40mm** under **ORD PABAC 027-20.** 

The Procurement Project (referred to herein as "Project") is composed **of** one *lot*, the details of which are described in Section VII (Technical Specifications).

## 2. Funding Information

- 2.1. The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for **2020** in the amount of *Ninety-Eight Million One Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Two Pesos (PhP98,196,992.00).*
- 2.2. The source of funding is **The General Appropriations Act.**

## 3. Bidding Requirements

The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including its Generic Procurement Manuals and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.

Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or **IB** by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.

The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have verified and accepted the general requirements of this Project, including other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

# 4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, and Coercive Practices

The Procuring Entity, as well as the Bidders and Suppliers, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of the contract. They or through an agent shall not engage in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices defined under Annex "I" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 or other integrity violations in competing for the Project.

## 5. Eligible Bidders

5.1. Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable will be evaluated.

- 5.2. Foreign ownership exceeding those allowed under the rules may participate pursuant to:
  - i. When a Treaty or International or Executive Agreement as provided in Section 4 of the RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR allow foreign bidders to participate;
  - ii. Citizens, corporations, or associations of a country, included in the list issued by the GPPB, the laws or regulations of which grant reciprocal rights or privileges to citizens, corporations, or associations of the Philippines;
  - iii. When the Goods sought to be procured are not available from local suppliers; or
  - iv. When there is a need to prevent situations that defeat competition or restrain trade.
- 5.3. Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have an SLCC that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be at least equivalent to:
  - a. For the procurement of Non-Expendable Supplies: The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to **at least fifty percent (50%)** of the ABC.
  - b. For procurement where the Procuring Entity has determined, after the conduct of market research, that imposition of (a) will likely result to failure of bidding that will defeat the purpose of public bidding: The Bidder should comply with the following requirements:
    - i. Completed at least two (2) similar contracts, the aggregate amount of which should be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) in the case of non-expendable supplies of the ABC for this Project; and
    - ii. The largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to **at least half of the percentage** of the ABC as required above.
- 5.4. The Bidders shall comply with the eligibility criteria under Section 23.4.1 of the 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.

# 6. Origin of Goods

There is no restriction on the origin of goods other than those prohibited by a decision of the UN Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the UN, subject to Domestic Preference requirements under **ITB** Clause 18.

## 7. Subcontracts

7.1. The Bidder may subcontract portions of the Project to the extent allowed by the Procuring Entity as stated herein, but in no case more than twenty percent (20%) of the Project.

However, the Procuring Entity has prescribed that Subcontracting is not allowed.

## 8. Pre-Bid Conference

The Procuring Entity will hold a pre-bid conference for this Project on the specified date and time and either at its physical address indicated herein and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting as indicated in paragraph 6 of the **IB**.

## 9. Clarification and Amendment of Bidding Documents

Prospective bidders may request for clarification on and/or interpretation of any part of the Bidding Documents. Such requests must be in writing and received by the Procuring Entity, either at its given address or through electronic mail indicated in the **IB**, at least ten (10) calendar days before the deadline set for the submission and receipt of Bids.

## 10. Documents comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

- 10.1. The first envelope shall contain the eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in **Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents)**.
- 10.2. The Bidder's SLCC as indicated in **ITB** Clause 5.3 should have been completed within the last five (5) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.
- 10.3. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. Similar to the required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.

# 11. Documents comprising the Bid: Financial Component

11.1. The second bid envelope shall contain the financial documents for the Bid as specified in **Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents)**.

- 11.2. If the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder or Domestic Entity, a certification issued by DTI shall be provided by the Bidder in accordance with Section 43.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 11.3. Any bid exceeding the ABC indicated in paragraph 1 of the **IB** shall not be accepted.
- 11.4. For Foreign-funded Procurement, a ceiling may be applied to bid prices provided the conditions are met under Section 31.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

## 12. Bid Prices

- 12.1. Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be entered separately in the following manner:
  - a. For Goods offered from within the Procuring Entity's country:
    - i. The price of the Goods quoted EXW (ex-works, ex-factory, ex-warehouse, ex-showroom, or off-the-shelf, as applicable);
    - ii. The cost of all customs duties and sales and other taxes already paid or payable;
    - iii. The cost of transportation, insurance, and other costs incidental to delivery of the Goods to their final destination; and
    - iv. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, listed in e.
  - b. For Goods offered from abroad:
    - i. Unless otherwise stated in the **BDS**, the price of the Goods shall be quoted delivered duty paid (DDP) with the place of destination in the Philippines as specified in the **BDS**. In quoting the price, the Bidder shall be free to use transportation through carriers registered in any eligible country. Similarly, the Bidder may obtain insurance services from any eligible source country.
    - ii. The price of other (incidental) services, if any, as listed in **Section VII (Technical Specifications).**

## 13. Bid and Payment Currencies

13.1. For Goods that the Bidder will supply from outside the Philippines, the bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for

purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies, shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.

13.2. Payment of the contract price shall be made in **Philippine Pesos**.

## 14. Bid Security

- 14.1. The Bidder shall submit a Bid Securing Declaration or any form of Bid Security in the amount indicated in the **BDS**, which shall be not less than the percentage of the ABC in accordance with the schedule in the **BDS**.
- 14.2. The Bid and bid security shall be valid until **one hundred twenty (120) calendar days from the date of opening of bids**. Any Bid not accompanied by an acceptable bid security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

## 15. Sealing and Marking of Bids

Each Bidder shall submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid.

The Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid. However, failure of the Bidders to comply with the said request shall not be a ground for disqualification.

If the Procuring Entity allows the submission of bids through online submission or any other electronic means, the Bidder shall submit an electronic copy of its Bid, which must be digitally signed. An electronic copy that cannot be opened or is corrupted shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.

## 16. Deadline for Submission of Bids

16.1. The Bidders shall submit on the specified date and time and either at its physical address or through online submission as indicated in paragraph 7 of the **IB**.

## 17. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids

17.1. The BAC shall open the Bids in public at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in paragraph 9 of the **IB**. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In case videoconferencing, webcasting or other similar technologies will be used, attendance of participants shall likewise be recorded by the BAC Secretariat. In case the Bids cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the rescheduling requirements under Section 29 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall prevail.

17.2. The preliminary examination of bids shall be governed by Section 30 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

## **18. Domestic Preference**

18.1. The Procuring Entity will grant a margin of preference for the purpose of comparison of Bids in accordance with Section 43.1.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

## 19. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

- 19.1. The Procuring BAC shall immediately conduct a detailed evaluation of all Bids rated "*passed*," using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria. The BAC shall consider the conditions in the evaluation of Bids under Section 32.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 19.2. If the Project allows partial bids, bidders may submit a proposal on any of the lots or items, and evaluation will be undertaken on a per lot or item basis, as the case maybe. In this case, the Bid Security as required by **ITB** Clause 15 shall be submitted for each lot or item separately.
- 19.3. The descriptions of the lots or items shall be indicated in Section VII (Technical Specifications), although the ABCs of these lots or items are indicated in the BDS for purposes of the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.2.6 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184. The NFCC must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.
- 19.4. The Project shall be awarded as **one contract.**
- 19.5. Except for bidders submitting a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NFCC computation, all Bids must include the NFCC computation pursuant to Section 23.4.1.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, which must be sufficient for the total of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder. For bidders submitting the committed Line of Credit, it must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABCs for all the lots or items participated in by the prospective Bidder.

# 20. Post-Qualification

20.1. Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the Bidder shall submit its latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and

Payment System (eFPS) and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the **BDS**.

# 21. Signing of the Contract

21.1. The documents required in Section 37.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall form part of the Contract. Additional Contract documents are indicated in the **BDS**.

# **Section IV. General Conditions of Contract**

# 1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the **Special Conditions of Contract** (**SCC**).

# 2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- 2.1. Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the revised 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the **SCC**.

# 3. Performance Security

Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award by the Bidder from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than prior to the signing of the Contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

# 4. Inspection and Tests

The Procuring Entity or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Project specifications at no extra cost to the Procuring Entity in accordance with the Generic Procurement Manual. In addition to tests in the **SCC**, **Section IV (Technical Specifications)** shall specify what inspections and/or tests the Procuring

Entity requires, and where they are to be conducted. The Procuring Entity shall notify the Supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes.

All reasonable facilities and assistance for the inspection and testing of Goods, including access to drawings and production data, shall be provided by the Supplier to the authorized inspectors at no charge to the Procuring Entity.

# 5. Warranty

- 5.1 In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty shall be required from the Supplier as provided under Section 62.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 5.2 The Procuring Entity shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof without cost to the Procuring Entity, pursuant to the Generic Procurement Manual.

# 6. Liability of the Supplier

The Supplier's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Supplier is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity.

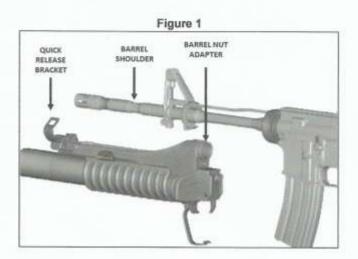

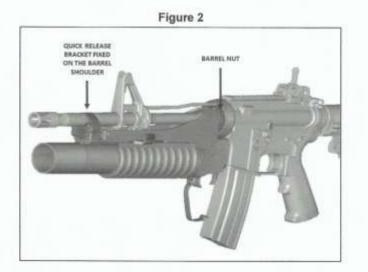

### 1. REFERENCES:

1.1. Technical Specifications for Launcher, Grenade, 40mm: Under Barrel dated \_\_\_\_\_\_

 MIL-L-45935A Military Specification for Launcher, Grenade, 40mm: Detachable, M203 dated 05 September 1974 (reactivated 21 January 2011).

 ANSI/ASQ Z1.4-2003: Sampling Procedures and Tables for Inspection by Attributes.

### 2. OBJECTIVES:

2.1 To determine the functional reliability of the weapon.

2.2 To determine the performance of the weapon when subjected to adverse field and storage conditions.

2.3 To determine user safety when weapon is fired in various environmental conditions.

2.4 To ascertain compliance to standards and specifications.

#### GUIDELINES:

3.1 The manufacturer/supplier shall ensure that the complete quantity stated in the contract is packed/palletized prior to the inspection.

3.2 Technical inspection and test shall be conducted on the representative samples of the lot through visual/physical, weight and dimensional measurements to determine the over-all workmanship, markings, color and appropriate packaging of the items.

3.3 Functional Test will be done to determine the functional performance of the weapon.

3.4 Results obtained shall be recorded and evaluated to determine the compliance of the items to technical specifications and as basis for acceptance or rejection of the lot or lots.

#### 4. PROCEDURES:

### 4.1 COMPLETENESS INSPECTION AND RANDOM SAMPLING:

The Technical Inspection and Acceptance Committee (TIAC) for Ordnance-Firepower/ Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) Team shall check the

completeness of the goods and conduct random sampling from the lot or lots. The samples shall be properly segregated, packed, marked and secured by the members. (See Para 4.3. – Allocation and Criteria for Representative Samples)

### 4.2. TEST AND INSPECTION PARAMETERS:

#### 4.2.1. PHYSICAL INSPECTION:

### 4.2.1.1. FOR THE PACKAGING:

4.2.1.1.1. Purpose: This non-destructive test shall be performed to determine the overall workmanship, conformity to technical specifications of the packaging and its markings to ensure that the inspected item shall be free from defects and meet the requirements of the Philippine Army.

#### 4.2.1.1.2. Procedures:

4.2.1.1.2.1. Visually check the packaging.

4.2.1.1.2.2. Inspect the presence and appropriateness of the markings.

4.2.1.1.2.3. Inspect for signs of deterioration, condition of handles, loose, missing or incorrect positioned parts.

4.2.1.1.2.4. Check for the compliance of the packaging material using appropriate instruments that will precisely identify the composition of the materials. In the absence of facility or equipment, a certification or manufacturing test result shall be provided.

4.2.1.1.2.5. Record all observations.

4.2.1.1.3. Standards: The packaging shall be free from defects as stated in the Types and Classifications of Defects- Visual Inspection - Packaging.

### 4.2.1.2. FOR THE LAUNCHER:

4.2.1.2.1. Purpose: This non-destructive test shall be performed to determine the overall workmanship, conformity to technical specifications of the launcher and to ensure that it is free from defect and meet the requirement of the Philippine Army.

#### 4.2.1.2.2. Procedures:

4.2.1.2.2.1. The sample launcher, its parts or components shall be visually inspected for its compliance on the physical/material technical data requirement using X-Ray Fluorescence (XRF) spectrometers/ analyzers or other appropriate instruments that will precisely identify the composition of the materials. In the absence of facility or equipment, a certification or manufacturing test result shall be provided.

4.2.1.2.2.2. Inspect for the presence and appropriateness of markings.

4.2.1.2.2.3. Each sample shall be examined for presence/ evidence of defect on workmanship.

4.2.1.2.2.4. The launcher shall be attached to the standard weapon (as indicated in the weapons application or its equivalent).

4.2.2. WEIGHT AND DIMENSIONAL INSPECTION:

4.2.2.1. Purpose: This test shall be performed to determine compliance of the launcher to the provided weight and dimensional requirement in the technical specifications of the Philippine Army.

4.2.2.2. Procedures:

4.2.2.2.1. The sample launcher, its parts or components shall be measured by using a weighing scale, go and no-go gages, vernier caliper, micrometer caliper or other appropriate measuring instruments.

4.2.2.2.2. Record the weight and dimensions.

4.2.2.3. Standard: The launcher shall be free from defects as stated in the Types and Classifications of Defects- Weight and Dimensional Inspection.

### 4.2.3. PERFORMANCE TESTS:

A series of tests shall be performed to ensure that the launcher will efficiently function and perform accordingly based on the established standards and specifications when subjected to various methods of actuation simulating field usage and storage conditions.

#### 4.2.3.1. TRIGGER PULL TEST:

4.2.3.1.1. Purpose: This test shall be performed to determine conformity of the trigger pull of the launcher as required in the technical specifications.

4.2.3.1.2. Procedure:

4.2.3.1.2.1. Measure the trigger pull using force gauge

4.2.3.1.2.2. Observe for creep or any irregular trigger behavior by manually pulling the trigger.

4.2.3.1.2.3. Record observations.

4.2.3.1.3. Standard: Trigger pull shall be according to

specification.

or any equivalent.

#### 4.2.3.2. RATE OF FIRE TEST:

4.2.3.2.1. Purpose: This test shall be performed to determine conformity of the launcher's rate of fire.



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### 4.2.3.2.2. Procedures:

4.2.3.2.2.1. The launcher shall be attached to a standard weapon (as indicated in the weapons application or its equivalent).

4.2.3.2.2.2. Using appropriate type of ammunition, the handheld weapon shall be fired as many rounds as possible for a duration of one minute.

4.2.3.2.2.3. Repeat three (3) times and note the average.

### 4.2.3.2.3. Standard:

4.2.3.2.3.1. The average rate of fire of the launcher shall be within the specification.

4.2.3.2.3.2. The launcher shall be free from defects as stated in the Types and Classifications of Defects - Functional Defects.

### 4.2.3.3. TARGETING AND ACCURACY TEST:

4.2.3.3.1. Purpose: This test shall be performed to determine conformity of the accuracy of the launcher when fired at 200 meters.

#### 4.2.3.3.2. Procedures:

**4.2.3.3.2.1.** The launcher shall be attached to a standard weapon (as indicated in the weapons application or its equivalent). Top edge of the front sight post flange of the rifle shall be set flush with or not more than .030 inch below the bottom surface of the of the front sight slot. The leaf sight shall be unfolded to the sighting position. No adjustment of the leaf sight shall be made after it has been set in the leaf sight alignment.

4.2.3.3.2.2. On benchrest position and by using appropriate type of ammunition, 20 rounds shall be fired to the target at a distance of 200 meters.

4.2.3.3.2.3. The range and deflection of each round shall be recorded.

4.2.3.3.2.4. Compute for standard deviation (range and deflection), probable error and center of impact of the 20-round group.

4.2.3.3.2.5. Wind condition during the firing shall not exceed 10 miles per hour.

4.2.3.3.3. Standard:

4.2.3.3.3.1. Targeting and accuracy of the launcher shall be according to the specification.

4.2.3.3.3.2. The launcher shall be free from defects as stated in the Types and Classifications of Defects- Functional Defects.

#### 4.2.3.4. MAXIMUM RANGE TEST:

4.2.3.4.1. Purpose: This test shall be performed to determine conformity of the maximum range of the launcher as required in the specifications.

4.2.3.4.2.3. Record observations

4.2.3.4.3. Standard:

4.2.3.4.3.1. Maximum Range of the launcher shall be according to specification.

4.2.3.4.3.2. The launcher shall be free from defects as stated in the Types and Classifications of Defects- Functional Defects.

#### 4.2.3.5. DROP SAFETY TEST:

4.2.3.5.1. Purpose: To determine durability and whether the launcher will fire upon impact when dropped.

4.2.3.5.2. Procedures:

4.2.3.5.2.1. The launcher shall be attached to the standard weapon (as indicated in the weapons application or its equivalent).

4.2.3.5.2.2. Conduct any applicable or appropriate testing procedure that will properly determine safety of the launcher when dropped from a height of 1.3 meters.

4.2.3.5.2.3. Inspect the weapon and ascertain the position of the safety switch and check to see if the launcher has fired.

 4.2.3.5.2.4. Conduct firing test if the serviceability of the launcher is questionable.

4.2.3.5.2.5. Record observations.

4.2.3.5.3. Standard: Performance of the launcher shall be according to specification.

#### 4.2.3.6. INTERCHANGEABILITY TEST:

4.2.3.6.1. Purpose: To determine the interchangeability of the parts of the launcher.

4.2.3.6.2. Procedures:

4.2.3.6.2.1. Launcher shall be tested for interchangeability of parts by disassembling the launcher and interchanging the parts using appropriate procedures.

4.2.3.6.2.2. The launcher shall be re-assembled and shall be tested for trigger pull and functional firing of two (2) rounds per launcher.

### 4.2.3.6.3. Standard:

4.2.3.6.3.1. Performance of launcher shall be according

to specification.

4.2.3.6.3.2. The launcher shall be free from defects as stated in the Types and Classifications of Defects- Functional Defects.



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### 4.2.3.7. FUNCTIONAL TEST:

4.2.3.7.1. Purpose: To determine if the launcher can withstand firing of 72 rounds without malfunction and damage.

4.2.3.7.2.1. The launcher cleaned and lightly oiled shall be attached to the standard weapon (as indicated in the weapons application) and set on a rifle rest.

4.2.3.7.2.2. Set the fire selector to Safe position then pull the trigger to check whether the launcher will fire or not

4.2.3.7.2.3. Using appropriate type of round, a four (4) 18-round series shall be fired from the launcher. Each series shall be fired within 4 minutes including reloading time.

4.2.3.7.2.4. Conduct visual, gauging and crack inspection as applicable to determine damage on the launcher after each series.

4.2.3.7.2.5. Record observation.

4.2.3.7.2.6. A 15-minute cooling period and preparation is allowed between each series.

4.2.3.7.3. Standard: Performance of the launcher shall be according to specification.

Note: During the test, the proponent is allowed to clean the launcher after each test/functional firing in preparation for the next test. However, cleaning shall be done in the presence of test team members.

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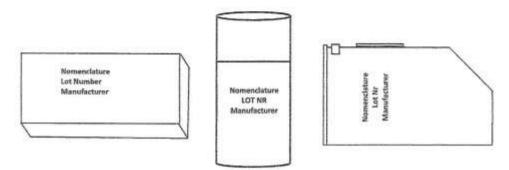

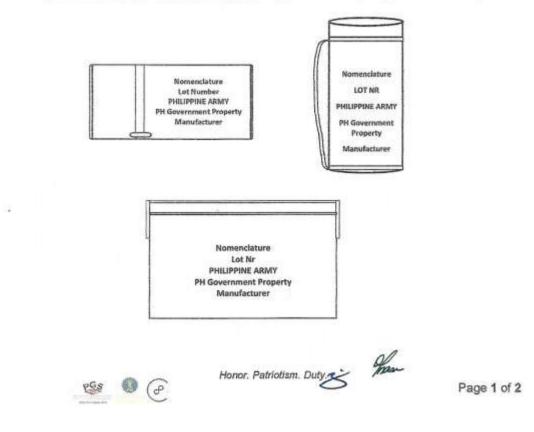
SAMPLE DIAGRAM FOR MARKINGS ON PACKAGING OF

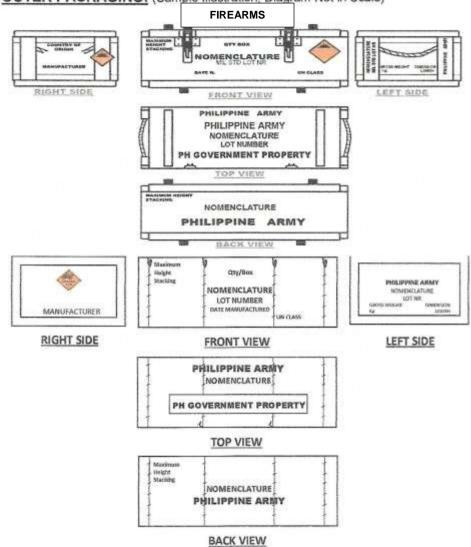

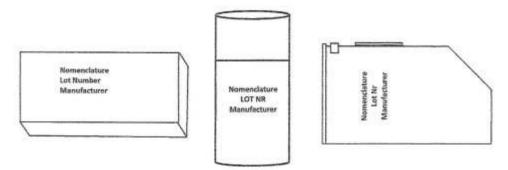

# SAMPLE DIAGRAM FOR MARKINGS ON PACKAGING OF FIREARMS

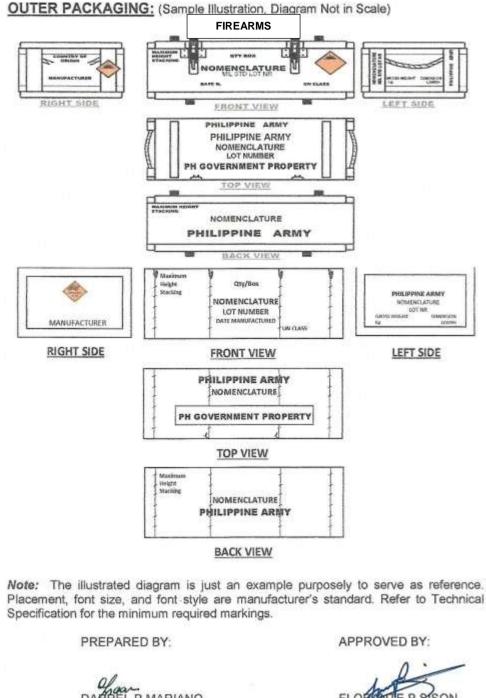
INNER PACKAGING: (Sample Illustration, Diagram Not in Scale)
