Percentage of tactical units provided to force employes that are in prescribed readiness condition	57%	57%	57%	57%	<b>57%</b>	16%	<b>16%</b>	<b>-41%</b>	For the period in review, out of the 196 tactical units provided to Unified Commands, 32 or 16% has attained the prescribed readiness condition of 81% (output indicator 3). PA's shortfall is largely attributed to the suspension of training activities in relation to COVID-19 pandemic crisis. Nonetheless, it is expected to increase once programmed training activities resume in the succeeding quarters.
2. Percentage of ready reserve units in prescribed readiness condition	40%	40%	40%	40%	<b>40%</b>	0%	<b>0%</b>	<b>-40%</b>	The non-attainment of the prescribed readiness condition of 65% for the 33RRBns or 40% of 82 RRBns is due to the application of GHQ Letter Directive Nr 01-2020 dated 05 Feb 2020 that the computation for readiness for RRUs will already consider four (4) KMAs instead of the previous two (2) KMAs based on the SOP Nr 20 AFP JRRS.

a. The Command is on track in attaining the 219 tactical battalions set for the year.

b. Ready Reserve Battalions	84	84	84	84	84	82	82	-2	PA has not attained the set target for RRBns with 99% accomplishment due to the current security situation in the area of Jolo, Sulu. The 906CDC was only activated on 23 July 2019 and still in the process of recruiting potential reservists in the province of Sulu that will form part of the 906RRBn. The 1406RRBn (Apayao) will be activated before the end of the year.
2. Percentage of operational readiness of tactical and ready reserve units									
a. Tactical Battalions	81%	81%	81%	81%	81%	74%	74%	-7%	PA's shortfall is largely attributed to the low training readiness condition of tactical battalions for the period in review. The low training readiness condition is due the suspension of training activities in relation to COVID-19 pandemic crisis. But still, it is expected to increase upon completion of programmed training by year-end.
b. Ready Reserve Battalions	65%	65%	65%	65%	65%	15%	15%	-50%	The 15% physical accomplishment rate for 1st quarter of FY 2020 is due to COVID-19 pandemic which resulted to the delay in implementation of programmed unit and individual trainings. Completion of programmed trainings for RRBns by year-end will increase its operational readiness.

Average percentage of effective strength of tactical battalions that can be mobilized within 1 hour as dictated by higher authorities	90%	90%	90%	90%	90%	90%	90%	0%	The accomplishment rate is 100% in compliance to the policy that requires the number of ineffective personnel at any time shall not exceed by 10% of the actual strength of each unit that can be translated into high combat effectiveness of tactical battalions.
